The inSilver workshop is a fantastic environment for making jewellery, it is full of interesting tools, chemicals and at times, hot metals. As your safety is paramount, each session begins with a brief health and safety talk. Before arriving for your jewellery making workshop experience, please read through the information below for your own safety and comfort.

- Making jewellery requires a lot of close work, don't forget your glasses if you need them!
- Eye protection and dust masks are provided as a precaution when polishing.
- Long hair should be tied back, this is a safety issue as we will use a gas flame torch and also rotary electrical polishers, neither work well with long floppy hair!
- Don't wear your best clothes! Although wearing jewellery is glamorous, polishing it is not and can get quite messy, aprons are provided.
- The workshop is a cold building even in the summer! Please dress with this in mind, layers work perfectly!
- In the summer months, please do not wear open toe shoes or sandals, we use heavy tools and hot metals if dropped they could hurt your feet!
- Photographs will be taken throughout the session for promoting the workshops. They are posted onto the inSilver Facebook and Instagram pages. Copies of the photographs that are taken can be emailed to you for your own use. If you are making the piece of jewellery for a gift for someone else, please also let me know, I'm more than happy to publicise the workshop at a later date so that I don't spoil the surprise! If you prefer not to star in these posts, then please let me know, I always ask your permission on the day and there is no need to feel obliged!
- Tea, coffee, cold drinks and biscuits are provided we have a toilet too!
